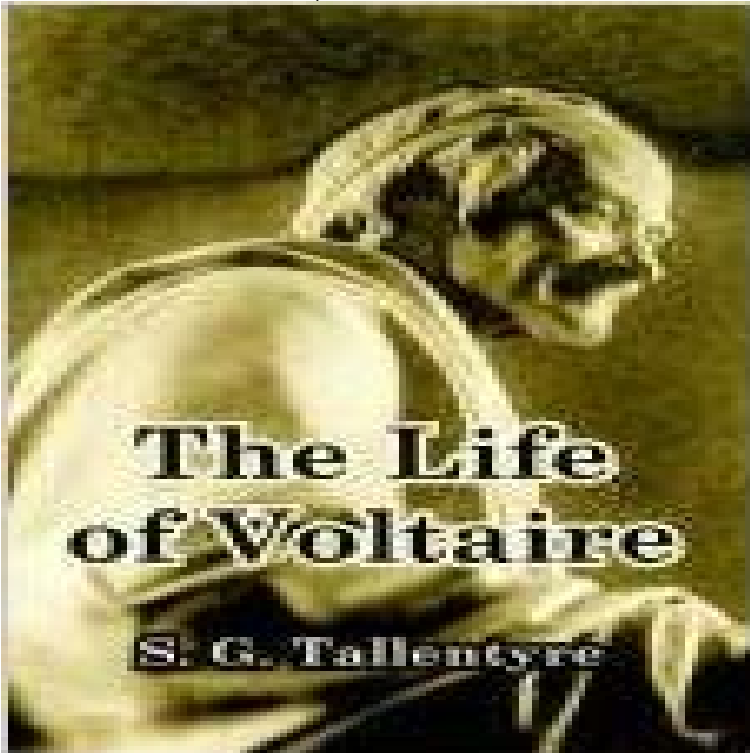


Life of Voltaire, The
