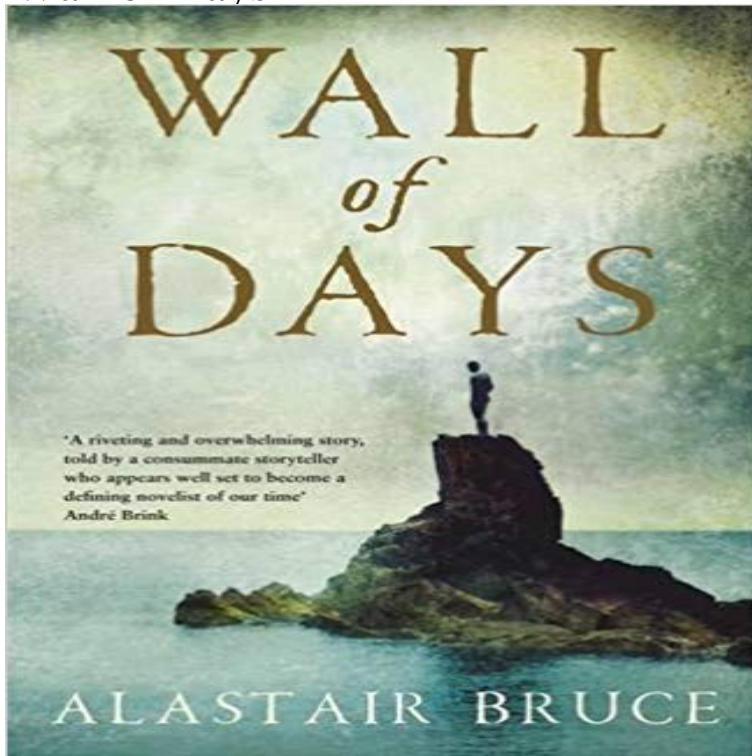


Wall of Days
