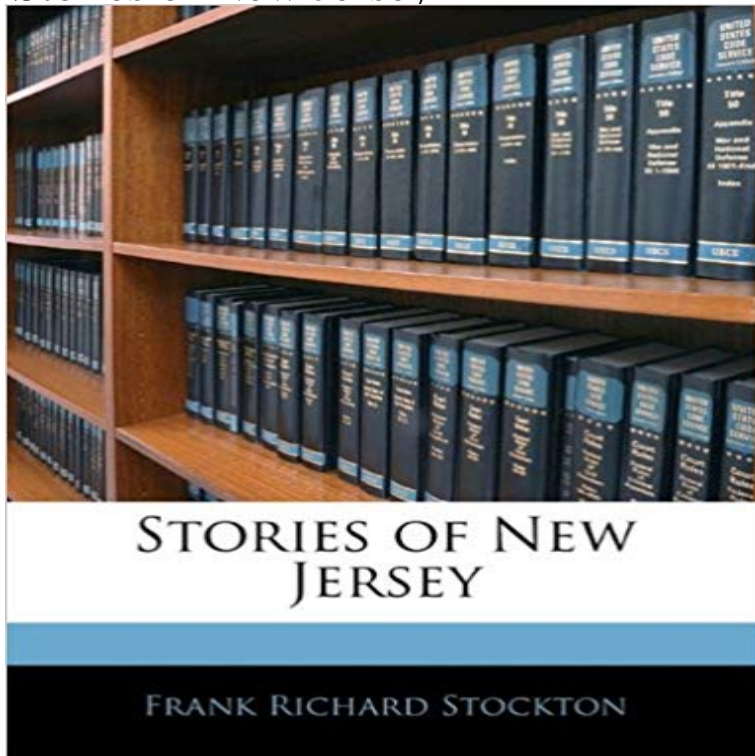


## Stories of New Jersey
