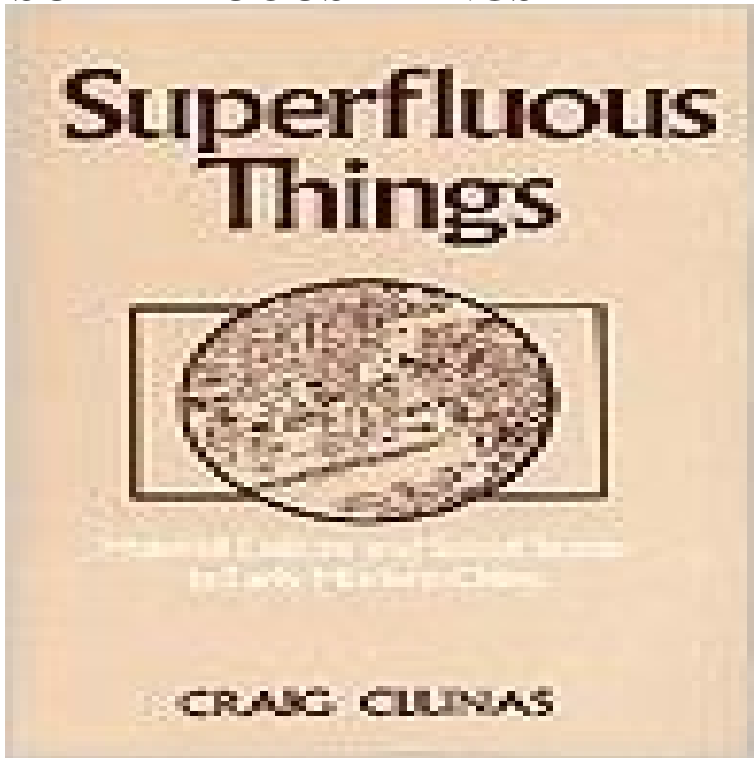


## SUPERFLUOUS THINGS
