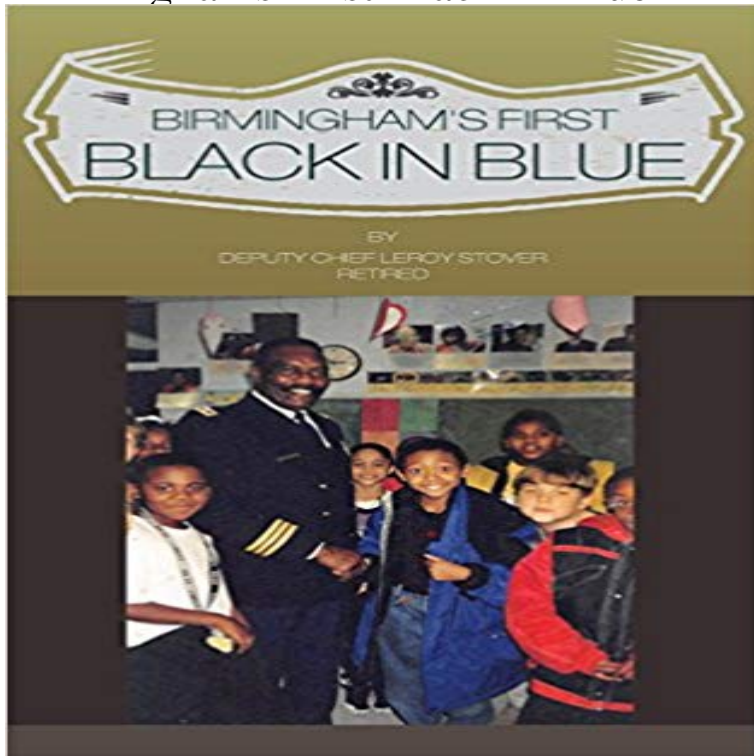


## Birmingham's First Black in Blue
