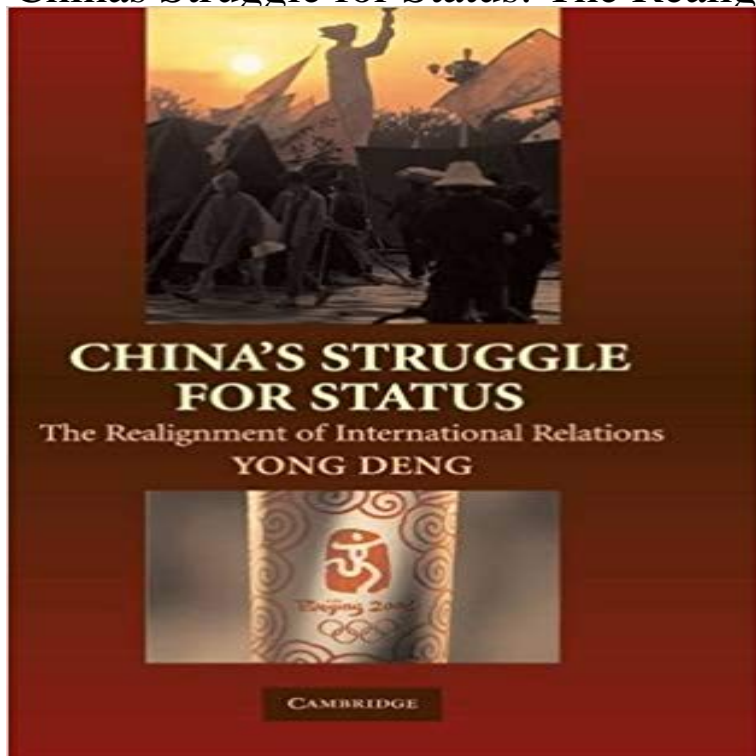


Chinas Struggle for Status: The Realignment of International Relations
