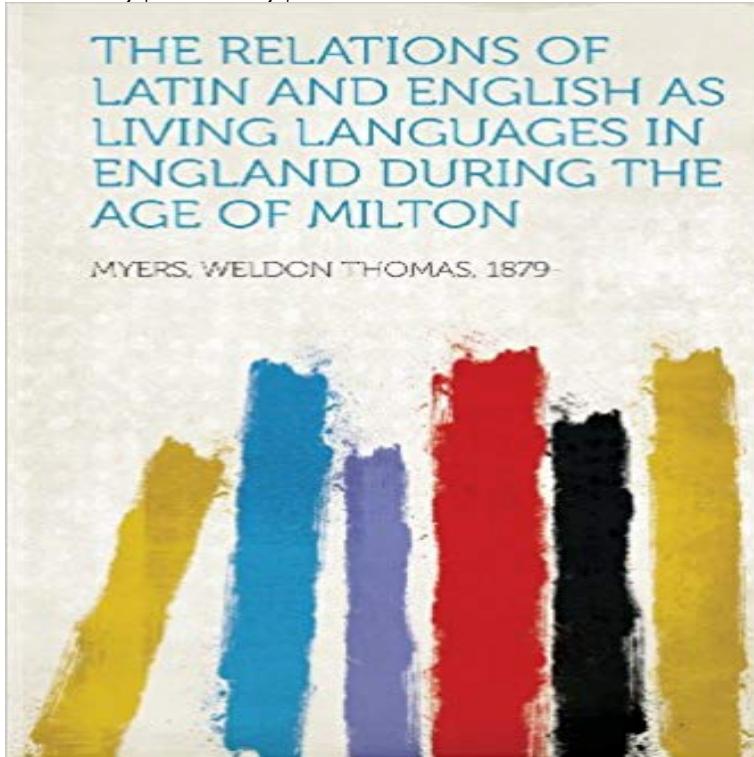


The Relations of Latin and English as Living Languages in England During the Age of Milton
